We need a reasonable time to review the 500 pages of supplemental production you sent less than two days ago.

As to your arbitrary "deadline," I wrote on July 25 that the State rejects Plaintiffs' ineffectual efforts to set arbitrary deadlines for the State. We refuse to participate in Plaintiffs' game of "respond-by-5:00 P.M-or else." As a good-faith effort to accommodate Plaintiffs' school schedules, we continue to *tentatively* hold open the dates Plaintiffs requested. But we cannot drop every other matter on our very active litigation docket to respond on Plaintiffs' arbitrary and unreasonable timeline.
